All schools have at least one security guard	Cameras and servers updated
High visibility by building administration	CrisisGo PD for staff- emergency response
District Administration presence in the schools throughout the week	District has a Crisis Team with trained mental and medical professionals who have been trained in the PREPARE training model.
Clear book bags during transitions for K-12	Window armor on each classroom door to slide over the small glass pane
Home football games on Saturdays	1 additional Sharon Hill Police Officer
Increased District Administration presence at football games and use of the Evolv	Updated cameras to provided visibility in blind spots
Established a Discipline Committee and discipline matrix	District Threat Assessment Team meets on a monthly basis
Staggered APHS start for opening week	Each school has a Threat Assessment Team
No back packs, bags or purses (except clutches. They will be checked) at football games	Hourly walks to check doors- Security Officers
Evolve Weapon Detection System at APHS	Random searches at APHS
Counseling available for students and staff	Change in the dismissal process at APHS
Each building will continue to collaborate with the Building Emergency Response Team (BERT)	Scholarchip –ID and tracking system for students at APHS
